

Administration Information

Test administrators must allow the full amount of time allotted for test sessions. While some students may finish before the time allotted for testing ends, this policy is in place to provide a fair environment for students who require all or most of the allotted time and to avoid pressuring any student to finish early.

Any student who has not finished by the end of the allotted time for an EOC session <u>may continue</u> working up to half the length of a typical school day.

Session Lengths by Grade Level and Subject

ELA Writing

ELA Writing assessments are administered in one 120-minute session.

ELA Reading

ELA Reading assessments are administered in two sessions over two days.

6	85 minutes	2 (two days)	Paper-Based
7-8	85 minutes	2 (two days)	Computer-Based

Mathematics

The Grade 6 Mathematics and Grades 7–8 Mathematics assessments are administered in three sessions over two days. For Grade 6 and Grades 7–8 Mathematics, Session 1 must be administered on Day 1 and Sessions 2 and 3 on Day 2.

FSA EOC Assessments

FSA EOC assessments are administered in two sessions over two days. Any student who has not completed a session by the end of the allotted time may continue working; however, **each session may last no longer than half the length of a typical school day**.

NGSSS EOC Assessments

For the Biology 1, Civics, and U.S. History EOC Assessment administrations, any student not finished by the end of the 160-minute test session may continue working; however, testing must be completed within the same school day.

Statewide Science

The Statewide Science Assessment for grade 8 is administered in two 80-minute test sessions. Grade 8 Science is administered in one day.
